

**Darlington FC welcomes visiting supporters to Blackwell Meadows. We hope you enjoy your visit and have a safe and enjoyable matchday experience.**

### **Ticket Information**

As a non-segregated fixture visiting supporters can buy tickets through general sale. Tickets can be purchased in advance online or paid on the gate using cash or contactless. We recommend online purchase for quickest entry into the ground.

Under 12s are free of charge with any paying adult or concession. A maximum of three children can enter per adult.

U18: £5

U12: Free

Concessions: 65+, 18-24, Students, Disabled. Carers admitted free of charge.

### **Matchday Hospitality**

Away supporters are welcome to join our matchday hospitality experience in the DFC Hospitality Suite. Hospitality bookings can be made online at <https://darlingtonfc.co.uk/hospitality>.

### **Seating**

Unreserved seating is in our main seated stand for pre-season matches. Our stewards will help supporters find available seats.

### **Entry and Turnstiles**

For non-segregated matches all supporters enter through the home turnstiles which are located to the left of the clubhouse and closest to the Tin Shed stand. Turnstiles open at 1.30pm for a 3pm kick off and at 6.30pm for a 7.45pm kick off. Early entry from 12.30pm/5.30pm via reception.

### **Clubhouse and Bar Access**

Visiting supporters are welcome in the clubhouse before, during and after the match. The clubhouse serves drinks and food and also shows live sport on TV. Early access is available on Saturday matchdays between 12.30pm and 1.30pm and on midweek matchdays between 5.30pm and 6.30pm.

### **Catering**

There are three catering outlets inside Blackwell Meadows. One is located next to the Tinshed and one is located adjacent to the club house (Pizzas). Food is also available in the

clubhouse. Matchday catering is provided in partnership with Darlington Rugby Football Club and we welcome feedback which is reviewed after each game.

### **Car Parking**

On site car parking is available on a first come first served basis at a cost of five pounds per car. Payment via cash, contactless or by purchasing in advance through our ticket portal. A limited number of Blue Badge spaces are also available and these should be reserved in advance online via our ticket portal.

Supporters should allow a few additional minutes when exiting the car park after the match as vehicle and pedestrian flows pass through the same exit point under steward guidance.

### **Where Visiting Fans Stand**

At non segregated fixtures away supporters may walk around the ground freely with the exception of the Tin Shed which is reserved for home supporters.

### **Accessibility and Support for Visually Impaired Fans**

Darlington FC offers an in stadium live audio commentary service for supporters with sight loss or visual impairment. Supporters can request a small wireless receiver and earpiece allowing them to hear Darlo Fans Radio coverage without delay anywhere in the ground. This initiative is supported by the Darlington FC Supporters Group.
